



Valladolid Study Program—Summer 2010

THE SITE

The University of Valladolid in Valladolid, Spain

LOCATION

Valladolid is located in the northwest center of the meseta castellana (the high Castillian plateau) in what was once known as Old Castile, about 120 miles northwest of Madrid. It is now the capital of the Comunidad Autónoma de Castilla-León. Valladolid is a large urban center with a population of 335,000. It still holds all the charm of a mid-size, provincial city.

DATES:

July 4-31, 2009. APPLICATIONS DUE MARCH 30, 2010

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS (NON-WAIVABLE):

- Cal Poly students with at least a 2.5 overall GPA at the time of application.
- One term (quarter or semester) of college-level Spanish or equivalent credit
- Have been enrolled in at least 24 units at Cal Poly at time of application
- Valid passport

THE PROGRAM

Students are enrolled in 8 units, 4 are in language study at the appropriate level (beginning to advanced), and 4 are Cal Poly courses offered by Cal Poly faculty on site.

COST

The cost* of the program is \$4750.00 and includes:

- Full tuition costs
- All insurance costs
- Welcome dinner in Madrid
- Transportation from Madrid to Valladolid
- Full access to all Universidad de Valladolid facilities
- Room and board--double occupancy with host families. (Other options are available at different rates not included in this price)
- 3 full-day excursions in Castilla-Leon
