Dear Political Science Students,

The 2006-2007 College Based Fee (CBF) Committee surveyed students during fall quarter 2006 and identified a number of spending priorities based on the survey results. The CBF committee allocated funds to courses, department website redesign, student assistantships for research and internship projects, field trips, and speakers. The committee worked diligently to create interesting and useful opportunities for student learning with CBF funds.

CBF funds supported eleven student research assistantships and sixteen student internship assistantships for the academic year. Students involved in assistantships can work with professors on research projects or undertake projects in a community organization or company associated with the Political Science Department internship program.

CBF field trip funds supported several important field trips associated with Political Science student clubs. CBF funds will be used for conference travel for the Model United Nations program, enabling students to attend the Harvard National Model United Nations conference in February 2007. Additionally, the newly formed Cal Poly Mock Trial team will use CBF funds to attend the regional Mock Trial competition in February 2007, and the Undergraduate Law Association will visit UCLA law school, attending a constitutional law class and meeting with law professors.
