GUIDELINES FOR MINORS

A minor is not required for graduation but may be used to complement the program of study. A minor is a formal aggregate of classes in a specific subject designed to give a student documented competency in a secondary course of study. In contrast to concentrations, the minor stands alone and is distinct from and outside the student's degree major. The minor must be completed along with the requirements for the bachelor's degree; it cannot be completed later. Units used to satisfy the degree major requirements may not be applied to the minor. Selection of a major and a minor from the same discipline is not permitted.

The minor offers an integrated and coherent pattern of course work, with at least half of the units at the 300-400 level. A minor consists of 24-30 units; a minimum of one-half the required course work toward a minor must be completed in residence. Courses in the minor may not be counted toward the major, but may be used to satisfy support and general education requirements.

A minimum overall grade point average of 2.0 is required in all units counted for completion of the minor. Two-thirds of all units counted in the minor must be in coursed graded A to F except for those courses which are graded on a mandatory Credit/No Credit basis.

The student who wishes to complete a minor should contact the Theatre and Dance Department as early as possible and fill out this MINOR Agreement form, which is then filed in the department office. Please check with your advisor or the department secretary quarterly to update your form.

Upon completion, the Minor Agreement Form will be forwarded to the Evaluations Office. The minor will be noted in your permanent record but will not be shown on the diploma. In no case will a diploma be awarded for the minor.
