No more than twelve units may be transferred from another school or university, including study abroad from a non-CSU sponsored program, and 12 units must be completed in residence. CR/NC grading allowed only for elective course units as approved by student's major course of study. A minimum GPA of 2.75 must be maintained in all Minor courses. Minors must be worked on concurrently with the baccalaureate degree; certification will not be given after completion of the baccalaureate degree. Units in the Minor cannot be counted to complete major course requirements in the student's baccalaureate degree. Completion of Minor requirements will be verified by the Graduation Clerk at the time the baccalaureate degree is posted.
