

## **Questions You Can Ask at the On-Site Interview**

Be prepared to ask pertinent questions about the company or job—questions that can't be answered by looking at the company website. Here are some examples:

- What is a typical day like here?
- What would my typical day be like?
- How and how often would I be evaluated?
- What are your dress and meal policies?
- How would you characterize the atmosphere at the company?
- What kind of training if any can I expect?
- What skills or experiences would help someone to do well in the job I'm seeking?
- To whom would I report?
- Will I be assigned to a specific department or will I be rotated throughout the company?
- Does the company expect any kind of change in structure soon?
- What do you like about working here?
- What are the characteristics of someone who succeeds here?
- What is the company's management philosophy?
